Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

**33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
November 17, 2024**

Daniel 12: 1-3

Psalm 16: 5, 8-11

Hebrews 10: 11-14, 18

Mark 13: 24-32

Scriptures that speak of events to come at the end of time are often referred to as apocalyptic. The first reading from Daniel falls into that category, and it uses apocalyptic language to speak of what were present-day realities for the author of that book and his audience.

Likewise, Jesus in our Gospel passage calls our attention to the end of time to help us to think about our lives and our world in the present age. Listening to all these readings, what do you hear God saying to you about your life?

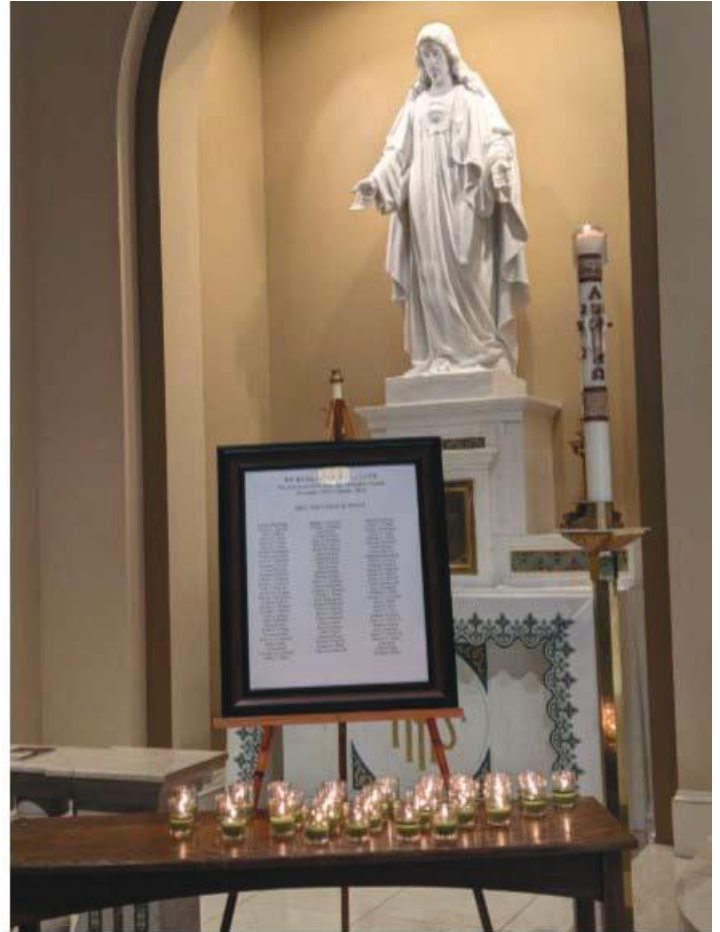

On Wednesday, we observe the **Feast of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini**, also known as Mother Cabrini. She was an Italian-American nun who founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. She was dedicated to caring for the poor, uneducated, sick, abandoned, and especially for the Italian immigrants in America. She founded 67 institutions in 35 years, including orphanages, schools and hospitals. She was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1946, she is the first United States citizen to be canonized, and she is the patron saint of immigrants.

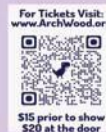

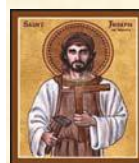

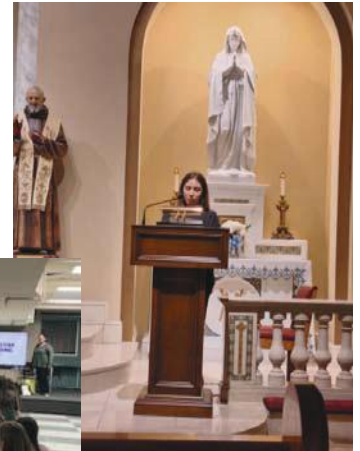
