Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My Dear Parishioners,

Today we begin the holy season of Advent! With Advent, the Church prepares us for the great feast of Our Savior's birth at Christmas. We enter now one of the most charitable gift-giving times of the year.

Many of us utilize this time to make sure that our charitable giving is where it should be, for income tax returns. However the most important reason to give to the needy is because this is the way we can show God our appreciation for sending his Son Jesus, that first Christmas. It's impossible to top his gift, but it's still worth the try.

One of the most effective ways that we can do that is by participating in our Parish's annual Gift-Giving Mass, this coming Wednesday December 4, at 7:00pm.

During the offertory of the Mass, everyone is invited to come forward with their wrapped presents for our needy brothers and sisters from the Hispanic community of St. Patrick's Parish in Norristown.

Unfortunately, over the last couple of years, attendance has continued to go down. I hope that you will come and reverse that trend!

Statement Regarding the Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati in 2025

My heart was filled with great joy to learn that Pope Francis will canonize Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati as saints next year!

This news ushers in great celebration for the Universal Church and especially for young Catholics. Blessed Carlo will be the first saint from the Millennial Generation and Blessed Pier Giorgio is a model of Missionary Discipleship for young adults leading busy lives while searching for true fulfillment.

Blessed Carlo, who died in 2016 at age 15, is an inspiration for children and adolescents through his passion for using technology to evangelize and share his devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist. Blessed Pier Giorgio, who died in 1925 at age 24, is a model for young adults through his dedication to serving the poor in urban areas while balancing university studies, social activism, and daily prayer.

Both of these saintly young men reflect the call for today's youth and young adults to live out their Catholic faith with courage, compassion, and divine love. Blessed Carlo, in particular, holds a special place in the heart of our local Church. We were blessed to host his mother, Antonia Salvano Acutis last fall when she spoke about her son's love and devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist at our Eucharistic Congress. Her reflections filled us with wonder and awe. They still resonate as we strive to follow in the footsteps of her son.

I pray that the inspiration flowing from Blessed Carlo and Blessed Pier Giorgio will fuel the zeal hearts of our young people to serve others with Christ as their model. Happy First Sunday of Advent! The time has come once again for us to prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas time and await his return at the Second Coming. Advent is a time to renew our dedica-

tion to God and remove anything from our lives and hearts, especially sin, that is separating us from God. If you have not been to confession in a while, please consider coming out with your entire family on Wednesday, December 18th to the Parish Confessions at 7 pm in the church. Confessions are also available always every



Saturday at 4 pm in the church. One way to make confession more of a family affair is to consider having mom or dad alternate taking the children in a group or individually then doing something fun after confession, like getting a treat, going for a walk, anything that your children really love to do with you so that you can tie everyday life and your love for your children into them going to confession. Give it a try!

Here are some more ideas to prepare for Christmas as a family:

- 1) Celebrate St. Nicholas Day- December 6th and teach your children about St. Nicholas the Bishop- helper of the poor and of children;
- 2) Set up an interactive nativity set that allows the children to participate by having them set up the nativity gradually and saving Baby Jesus to come out on Christmas day; and
- 3) Consider making a Jesse Tree, which you decorate each day until Christmas. It tells the whole story of salvation from Adam and Eve all the way to Jesus. (Catholic Company and EWTN have some good versions). Please check out the QR code to a YouTube video from Catholic Company that further explains the Jesse tree devotion.

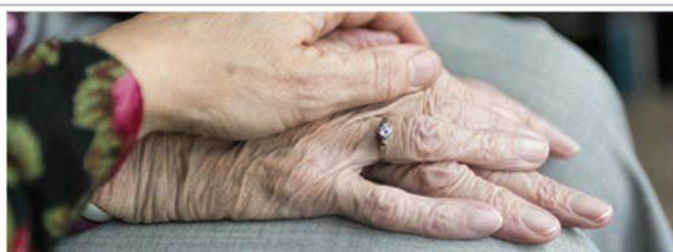
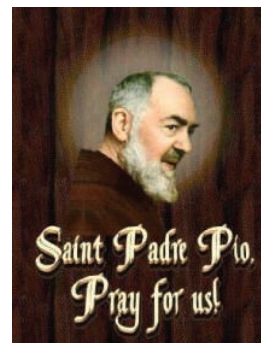
