A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Every year during Advent and Lent, the schedules of priests gets more fuller than usual. That's because we are going around to a number of parishes for Penance Services, and evenings when multiple priests help out with their confessions. As a priest, it is humbling to celebrate this sacrament, as we are the ones who sit in both chairs, if you will.

As a priest, you are there to help a person find comfort and experience the forgiveness of God. Confession isn't necessarily spiritual direction or therapy, but it is a moment where a person is reminded of how they are loved by God. And you can have a brief conversation with them, to help them to see that. And to think about something a little more deeply. Or give practical advice, which can be very consoling.

Most important of all though, you as a priest sit there, making Jesus present, and forgiving them in His name. Confession inspires me because I see such sincerity and honesty and good in people, because when that person leaves, they are unburdened and going to become a better man or woman or child.

I also go regularly to confession myself, often times to the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa in Doylestown, where two or three priests are available to celebrate the Sacrament of Confession every day at 11:15am. Pope Francis once surprised people when he went to confession in public, apparently standing in line to go in Rome at St. Peter's Basilica. What a great message to send to people. I recognize when I look at myself that I am a work in progress, always trying to become better. But someone who needs the grace of the sacrament to help me with my shortcomings.

So why should you consider going to confession, especially if you have been away, and especially during this blessed season of Advent? Here are a few reasons:

1. **Confidentiality guaranteed:** There's nothing like confessing your sins to someone guaranteed not to tell anyone else. Sometimes you need to talk to someone in absolute confidence.
2. **Housekeeping for the soul:** It feels good to be about to start a clean life, all over again.
3. **A balm for a desire for revenge:** When you have been forgiven, you can forgive others.
4. **Low-cost therapy:** But even a therapist cannot forgive your sin.
5. **Forced time to think:** Socrates once said, "The unexamined life is not worth living."
6. **Contribution to world peace:** Peace of soul leads to peace of heart, leads to peace beyond myself.
7. **A better neighborhood:** Confession leaves you feeling good about yourself, thereby cutting back the inclination to such things as road rage.
8. **Realistic self-perception:** Confessing helps overcome arrogance when you have to admit you're as much of a sinner as anyone else, but you have received the goodness and love of God.
9. **One more benefit of being Catholic:** It is the Sacrament that leads to inner peace.
10. **Closeness to God:** Any barrier to our closeness to God because of our sinfulness is reduced to ashes.

No matter where you are in life, never doubt God's love for you. His mercy is always there. He looks at you and me, and always sees our potential, what Christmas and Advent are all about. And Confession helps us to realize it.

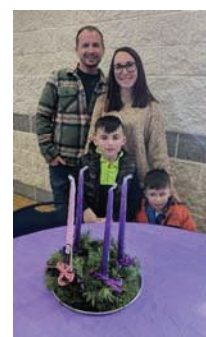

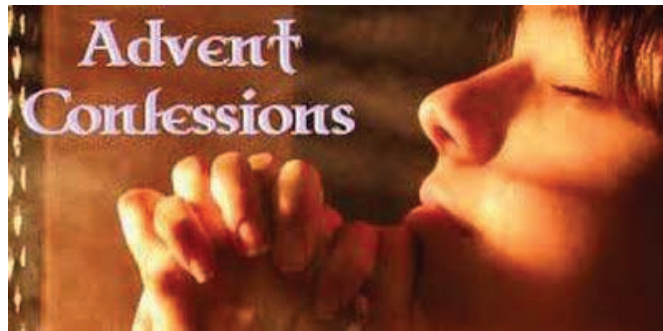

Form For Confession

(Cut out and bring with you)

Enter and say:

"Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been _____ since my last confession. These are my sins."
(Tell the priest your sins and the approximate frequency)

Then say:

"Father, I am sorry for these and all the sins of my past life, especially _____."

The priest speaks to you and suggests an appropriate penance. Then say the **Act of Contrition**:

***Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for
Having offended you, and I detest
All my sins, because of Your just
Punishments, but most of all
Because they offend You, My God, who are all-
good and deserving of all my love.
I firmly resolve, with the help of
Your grace, to sin no more and to
Avoid the near occasion of sin.***

Examination of Conscience

1. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. YOU SHALL NOT HAVE STRANGE GODS BEFORE ME.

- Do I give God time every day in prayer?
- Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart?
- Have I been involved in witchcraft, superstition or black magic?
- Have I received Communion in a state of mortal sin?
- Have I deliberately told a lie in Confession or withheld a mortal sin in Confession?

2. YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.

- Did I curse or swear? Did I use God's name in vain, lightly, carelessly, by blasphemy?
- Have I wished evil upon another person?
- Have I been angry with God and stayed in that state of anger?
- Have I insulted a sacred person or abused a sacred object?

3. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE LORD'S DAY.

- Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of obligation?
- Did I receive Holy Communion in the state of serious (mortal) sin?
- Have I tried to observe Sunday as a family day and a day of rest? Do I get enough rest or am I constantly running?
- Do I do needless work on Sunday?

4. HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.

- Do I honor and obey my parents? Am I respectful towards them?
- Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children?
- Have I given my family good religious example and try to bring peace into the home?
- Do I care for my aged and infirmed relatives?

5. YOU SHALL NOT KILL.

- Have I had an abortion or encouraged anyone to have an abortion?
- Have I mutilated myself through any form of sterilization? Have I encouraged or condoned sterilization?
- Have I harbored anger or resentment or hatred in my heart?
- Have I physically harmed anyone? Have I driven recklessly (too fast, showing off, etc.)?
- Have I abused alcohol or drugs?
- Have I hurt myself through cutting, scratching, or in any other way?

6. YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.

- Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action? Have I engaged in any sexual activity outside of marriage?
- Has each sexual act in my marriage been open to the transmission of new life?
- Have I engaged in any type of sexual activity (intercourse, oral sex, inappropriate touching, mutual masturbation)?
- Have I been guilty of masturbation? Have I entertained lustful thoughts?
- Have I been guilty of any homosexual activity?
- Do I seek to be chaste in my thoughts, words, and actions?
- Was I "immodest" in the way I dressed, acted or spoke (leading others to arousal)?
- Are my words, texts and photos on Facebook and/or other social media sites sexually charged?
- Did I look at pornography or visit chat rooms that were inappropriate?

7. YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.

- Have I stolen what is not mine?
- Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen?
- Did I waste time at work (which is really stealing from the company)?
- Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs?
- Do I seek to share what I have with the poor?

8. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR.

- Have I lied? Have I gossiped? Have I spoken behind someone else's back?
- Do I always tell the truth? Did I reveal secrets that should have been kept confidential?
- Am I sincere in my dealings with others?
- Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?
- Do I keep secret what should be kept confidential?
- Is what I write in my emails, IM's, text messages or on any social media sites true about myself or others?

9. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S WIFE.

- Have I consented to impure thoughts?
- Have I caused impure thoughts by impure reading, movies, conversations or curiosity?
- Do I seek to control my imagination?
- Do I pray at once to banish impure thoughts and temptations?

10. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.

- Am I jealous of what other people have? Do I envy the families or possessions of others?
- Am I greedy or selfish? Are material possessions the purpose of my life?
