On May 9, 2024, Pope Francis solemnly proclaimed the Jubilee Year of 2025 with the title “*Spes non confundit*” which, translated in Latin means “*Hope Does Not Disappoint.*” The Holy Father said, “*We must fan the flame of hope that has been given to us by Christ, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart, and far-sighted vision.*”

One of the traditional ways of celebrating the Jubilee Year is for pilgrims to make a pilgrimage to churches that have been specifically designated as Special Jubilee sites. I am pleased to announce that St. Bede the Venerable Church, which is considered the Archdiocesan Shrine of Padre Pio, has been selected by Archbishop Perez as one of these sites.

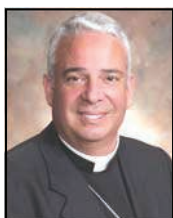

The Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025 promises many blessings for the clergy and faithful of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. In his *Bull of Indiction* for the Jubilee Year (*Spes non confundit*, May 9, 2024), Pope Francis gives a priority to the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation as well as the Jubilee Indulgence.

The Apostolic Penitentiary in response to the Holy Father’s instruction outlines the many wonderful and varied ways to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence. Among these are pilgrimages and pious visits to sacred places. **By way of this letter, I decree that your church and/or shrine is a Sacred Jubilee Site in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia for the clergy and faithful to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence.** Please read in full the *Decree on the Granting of the Indulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025 call by His Holiness Pope Francis*, May 13, 2024 (hereafter *Decree*). This Decree describes more fully how your church and/or shrine can assist all who make a pilgrimage and/or a pious visit as *Pilgrims of Hope*, with

privileged opportunities to encounter Our Lord Jesus Christ in His grace and mercy.

The Jubilee Indulgence is available to all who make a pilgrimage and/or a pious visit to your church and/or shrine from Sunday December 29, 2024 through Sunday December 28, 2025, in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. In addition to the pilgrimage and/or pious visit, “All the faithful, who are truly repentant and free from any affection for sin (see *Enchiridion Indulgentiarum*, IV ed., norm. 2, §1), who are moved by a spirit of charity and who, during the Holy Year, purified through the Sacrament of Penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions fo the Supreme Pontiff, will be able to obtain from the treasury of the Church a plenary indulgence, with remission and forgiveness of all their sins, which can be applied in suffrage to the souls in Purgatory (see *Decree*).”

You are asked to publish widely through electronic and print media the possibility, conditions and opportunities for the Jubilee Indulgence as a Sacred Jubilee Site. In addition, you are asked to arrange and publish a variety of occasions for the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation with special attention to the forms found in the *Order of Penance, 2013*.

I am very grateful to you and to all who will assist you during this Jubilee Year to provide with great generosity for the Jubilee Indulgence.

Scripture Readings for Next Sunday

The Epiphany of the Lord
January 5, 2025

Isaiah 60: 1-6
Psalms 72: 1-2, 7-8, 10-13
Ephesians 3: 2-3a, 5-6
Matthew 2: 1-12



The Psalm refrain expresses the essence of the celebration: "Lord, every nation on earth will adore you." From Isaiah's vision of a world beating a path to God's door, to Saint Paul's inclusion of Gentiles as copartners in the promise of Christ Jesus, to the appearance of magi from the East, we celebrate God's salvation for all people. As we listen to these readings, let us be mindful of the places in the world that desperately need to hear God's saving message.

Cornerstone for Life

**Pro-Life laws are saving babies
from abortion: here's more proof**

More evidence verifies that pro-life laws save lives, not merely by preventing all abortions, but by limiting the time during which they may be carried out. The data come from the annual abortion facility survey from Operation Rescue.



"Nearly one-third (30%) of abortion [facilities] commit surgical abortions at 20 weeks or later," notes the report tragically. "Thirty-seven percent of abortion [facilities] limit the gestational age to 13.9 weeks and under for surgical abortions. However, it should be noted that heartbeat protection laws in four states drive up the number in that category considerably, especially in Florida, which currently has the third highest number of abortion [facilities] — all of which are now required to limit abortions to far less than 14 weeks."

Based on this comment, we see the abortion industry would gladly extend abortion to the moment of birth. Even incremental approaches toward the ultimate goal of protecting all babies in law make a difference, by denying abortionists their goal of committing abortion until birth.

But the report shows the opposite is also true: A lack of legal protections for the unborn jeopardizes older and older babies. "Of the 36 states with legalized abortion, 25%," or nine states, "house one or more [facilities] that commit abortions beyond the maximum gestational age documented in 2023," it says.

The report noted that states with fewer abortion facilities, such as Utah, have higher costs — apparently indicating another way in which pro-life laws save lives.

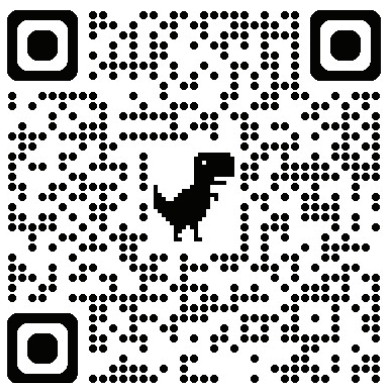

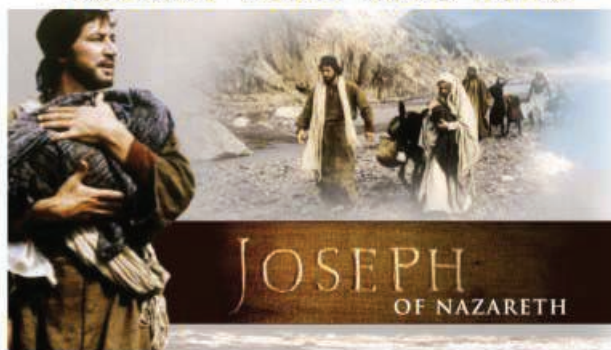
