Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

My dear parishioners,

Archbishop Nelson Pèrez, the Archbishop of Philadelphia, published a very important, if not historic, pastoral letter entitled, “**An Invitation from Archbishop Pèrez**” on Sunday January 5, 2025, the Feast of the Epiphany. This letter is important and historic in that it outlines his hopes for the Church of Philadelphia, to which we are all members, over the coming years.

The Archbishop is asking your help, and mine, in being a part of the process. Actually, the process is, as he says, “A conversation about our future, so your voices and presence are essential as we navigate our way forward as the Catholic Church of the greater Philadelphia area.”

As he notes in the letter, “We are living in times more like the earliest Christians. Times when many, often in our own families, are living without Christ.” Archbishop Perez wants to inspire a pastoral change of heart that focuses on those who are absent, and that align our collective efforts across parishes, schools and charitable ministries, to listen, rebuild trust, and invite people home.

He says to build up the Church, we must form our people to be Missionary Disciples. Over the next decade, Archbishop Pèrez wants to establish Missionary Hubs across the Archdiocese, averaging ten per county, planted at parishes and other locations. The goal is to reach out to Catholics who don't participate, and non Catholics, using



our resources and talents to ignite that spirit of missionary discipleship.

Through this column, I have offered just a brief summary of the Archbishop's letter. I strongly encourage you to read the letter in its entirety. The first thing to do is to visit <https://trustandhope.org>. By clicking the link or using the QR code below, watch the video and then reading the Archbishop's letter to us. You will find the video interesting in that there are numerous clips from one of our recent Padre Pio Festivals here at St. Bede, when the Archbishop joined us.

After that, please also consider signing up for one of the Archdiocesan consultation sessions, and learn even more. We will also have local information sessions here at St. Bede Parish, and we will share those dates as soon as we schedule them.

Isaiah 62: 1-5

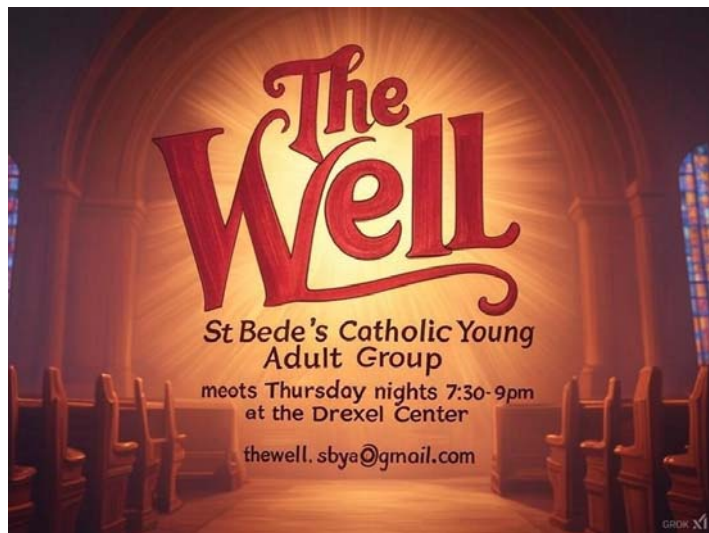
Psalms 96: 1-3, 7-10

FOOD DRIVE

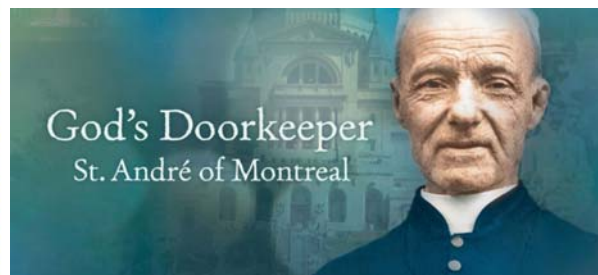

- Are prepared to fulfill each and every duty which active membership in the Legion involves.

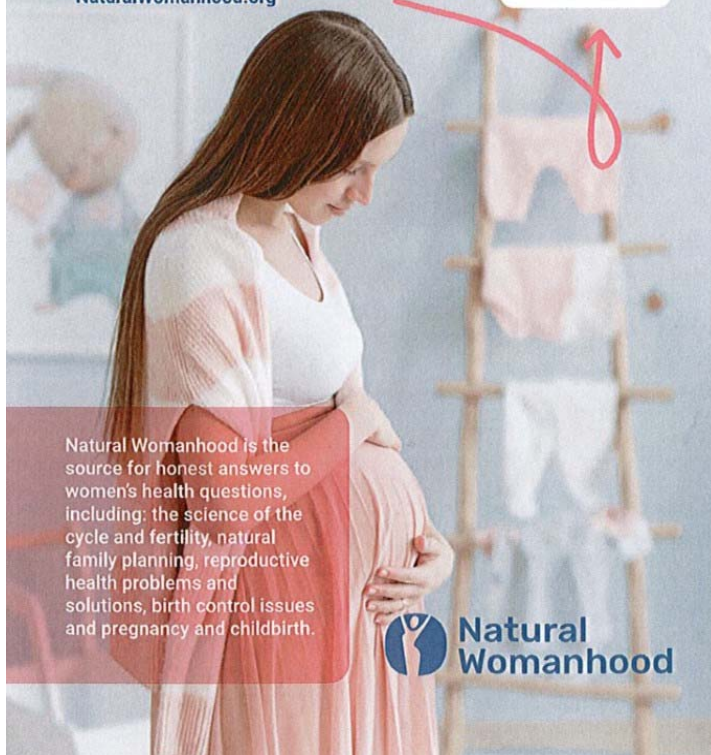

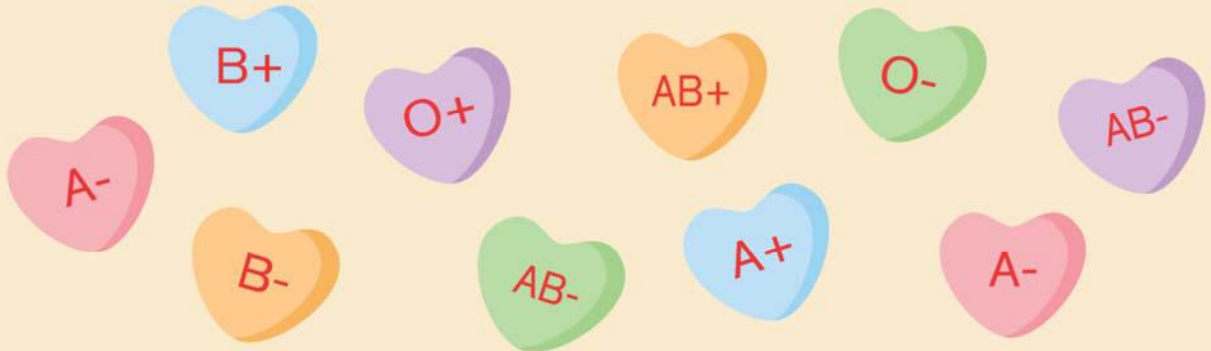
