Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

I love the Gospel for this Second Sunday of the year in Cycle C. It's so true to life. It tells the story of the Wedding feast of Cana. Anyone who has planned a wedding knows just how hard it is to plan for the thirsts and appetites of all your potential guests. Will they want the shrimp appetizer or the seared tuna? Will they want cabernet or pinot noir? Cousin Steve replied yes, but will he come?

There are countless questions and variables that can affect the flow and budget of a party. And it can be rightly understood when hosts are overwhelmed. Indeed, it is always good to have someone you know who can move suddenly or inconspicuously to help with final details that might have been missed.

You can picture Mary, Jesus' mother, as one of those guests who notice they were running out of wine. At best, it would have been understandable to the guests, and at worst, an embarrassment for the new couple.

Mary's intercession on behalf of the couple, and Jesus' subsequent miraculous intervention, is a powerful reminder to us of our own insufficiency. There is much in life, especially in the living out of our faith, from which we will be woefully unprepared. No priest, no matter how much training has the right words to comfort a bereaved family. No parent, no matter how experienced, has the magic formula to raise a perfect child every time. No student, no



matter how hard they study, will always have the answers to every question.

It is only when we recognize our limitations; when we become at peace with our imperfections, that we can really experience the magnificent new wine of life that God has prepared for us. When we give up trying to get everything right, and instead leave space for God's will to be done, do we find unexpected and unforeseeable joys, as that wedding couple did.

This spiritual attitude allows God to work miracles not only in our hearts, but also in and through others. And so we are brought here today to question our own need to control. Where in our lives do we over-think and over-calculate? Where do we refuse to trust in God's providence and care? Where do we fail to acknowledge that we are unprepared to deal with all of life's challenges? Where are we unwilling to ask God for that new wine He is longing to give us? My prayer for you and myself is that we might see God's trustworthiness in so many faithful people around us. Lean on them, and in that act of trust, know God's peace and care.

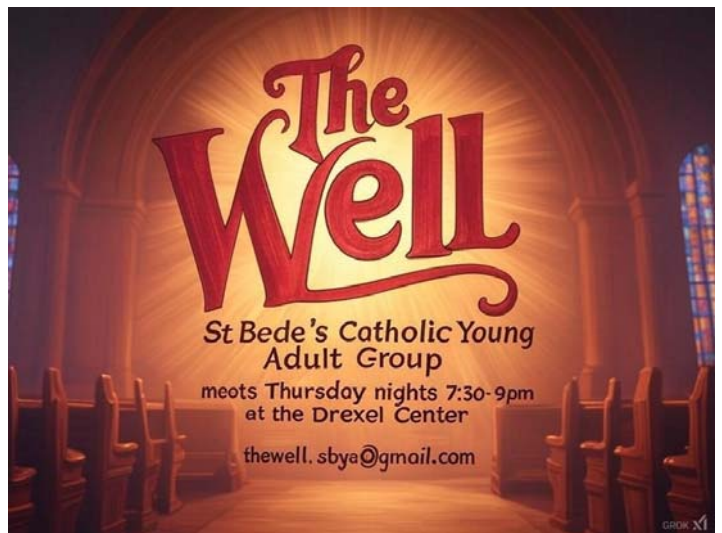
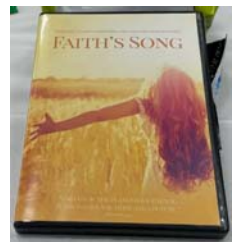

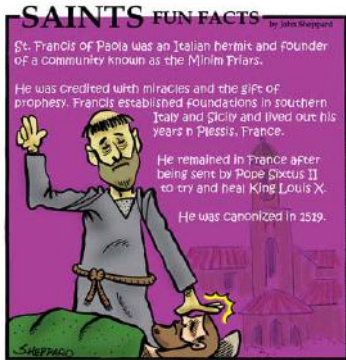

Well, fate, and the Saint Generator online, blessed me with St. Francis of Paola as my Saint of the Year – for the *second* time in 10 years. So, I figured God was telling me I did not learn everything He wanted me to learn the first time around.

St. Francis of Paola was a 15th century Italian miracle worker. After many years of not being able to conceive, his parents prayed for the intercession of St. Francis of Assisi that they may have a baby and their prayers were answered. According to tradition, while Francis was being born, the extraordinary sign of tongues of fire was seen over the family house by the town's people. Francis eventually went on to become a Franciscan hermit and monk, start the Order of Minims and dedicate his life to taking care of the poor. He was known to speak with animals and bring people back from the dead, among many other miracles. Francis died in France at the age of 91. His Feast Day is April 2nd and he is the patron of many cities in Italy and France, boatmen, mariners, and naval officers and against pandemics. 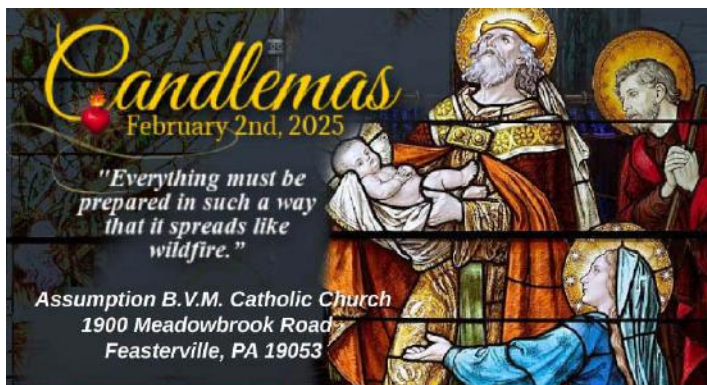
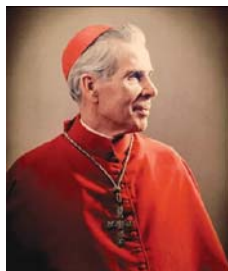
