## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Epiphany of Our Lord. What we commemorate on this solemnity, often nicknamed "Little Christmas" is the revelation, or "epiphany", of the Savior of the world to the Gentiles.

Mary and Joseph and the shepherds and eventually their neighbors were the first to look on the face of God in Jesus but they were all Jewish by religion and culture. When the three Magi, accompanied by their band of travelers, came to the place where the child was, they were the first Gentiles, or non-Jewish peoples, to behold Him. Thus, to Mary and Joseph and all the world came the revelation that God had sent his Son for *all* humanity.

The fascinating aspect of this account is the fact that the Magi were lead there by a star; but beyond that, they were also seeking for something or they would have never left their homes. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says: "the desire for God is written in the human heart because man is created by God and for God and God never ceases to draw man to himself."

Sometimes we search in other places for God, in earthly pursuits, but only in God do our hearts find ultimate joy. When we find God we are to share Him and be a star calling others to find what we have found.

In these remaining hours of the Christmas Season (which ends next Sunday with the Baptism of our Lord), let us consider how we can **allow our good example to shine** so that, like a star, we can bring others to Christ.

This can happen through our courageous testimony or by simply inviting someone to Mass or an event at our parish. Never underestimate your power to influence. Like the Magi, it is through your "starry light" that you will help others recognize what, or better stated "who" they have been looking for.

Finally, on behalf of Fr. Zehner, I thank you for your many kindnesses expressed at Christmas, and throughout the year. It was edifying to see the tremendous crowds of people who attended our Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses. We finally returned, if not surpassed, the attendance number we knew prior to the pandemic.

## Archdiocese announces pilgrimage to Italy for Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia, in partnership with Malvern Retreat House and ProRome Tours, will sponsor a week-long pilgrimage in Italy to honor Blessed Carlo Acutis and observe his canonization as a saint and as part of the Jubilee Year 2025 celebrations. All are invited to join Archbishop Nelson J. Pérez on this joyful pilgrimage.



The pilgrimage will take place April 23 to 29, 2025 in Rome, with an optional extension to Assisi from April 29 - May 1, 2025. This pilgrimage features hotel accommodations at the five-star Westin Excelsior in Rome, as well as a flexible touring program to accommodate all ages. Highlights include the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis in Saint Peter's Square, tours of the Papal Basilicas and Holy Doors, the Catacombs, the Pantheon and more.

## Cornerstone for Life

### Supreme Court Will Hear Case Upholding States' Right to Defund Planned Parenthood

The Supreme Court has agreed to hear a case that could uphold states' right to defund the Planned Parenthood abortion business.

The U.S. Supreme Court agreed Wednesday to hear *Kerr v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic*, a case that could decide whether pro-life states like South Carolina can direct Medicaid funds—funds intended to help low-income individuals obtain necessary medical assistance—away from abortion companies like Planned Parenthood.



*Kerr* arose after South Carolina's governor, Henry McMaster, issued an executive order directing the South Carolina Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) to deem abortion clinics unqualified to receive Medicaid funding. Planned Parenthood and an individual plaintiff immediately sued in federal court, challenging the state's decision.

Both the district court and the Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit ruled against South Carolina and the state appealed to the Supreme Court.

*Kerr* is a critically important case that could have a dramatic impact on the ability of the states to stop the flow of taxpayer dollars to the nation's largest abortion company.

Representing the director of the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Alliance Defending Freedom attorneys asked the high court to take the case following a decision by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 4th Circuit that ruled against the state.

"Taxpayer dollars should never be used to fund facilities that make a profit off abortion," said ADF Senior Counsel and Vice President of Appellate Advocacy John Bursch. "Pro-life states like South Carolina should be free to determine that Planned Parenthood and other entities that peddle abortion are not qualified to receive taxpayer funding through Medicaid. Congress did not unambiguously create a right for Medicaid recipients to drag states into federal court to challenge those decisions, so no such right exists. Applying the Supreme Court's recent decision in the *Talevski* case, we expect the court to hold that Congress did not intend to allow federal courts to second guess states' decisions about which providers are qualified to receive Medicaid funding."

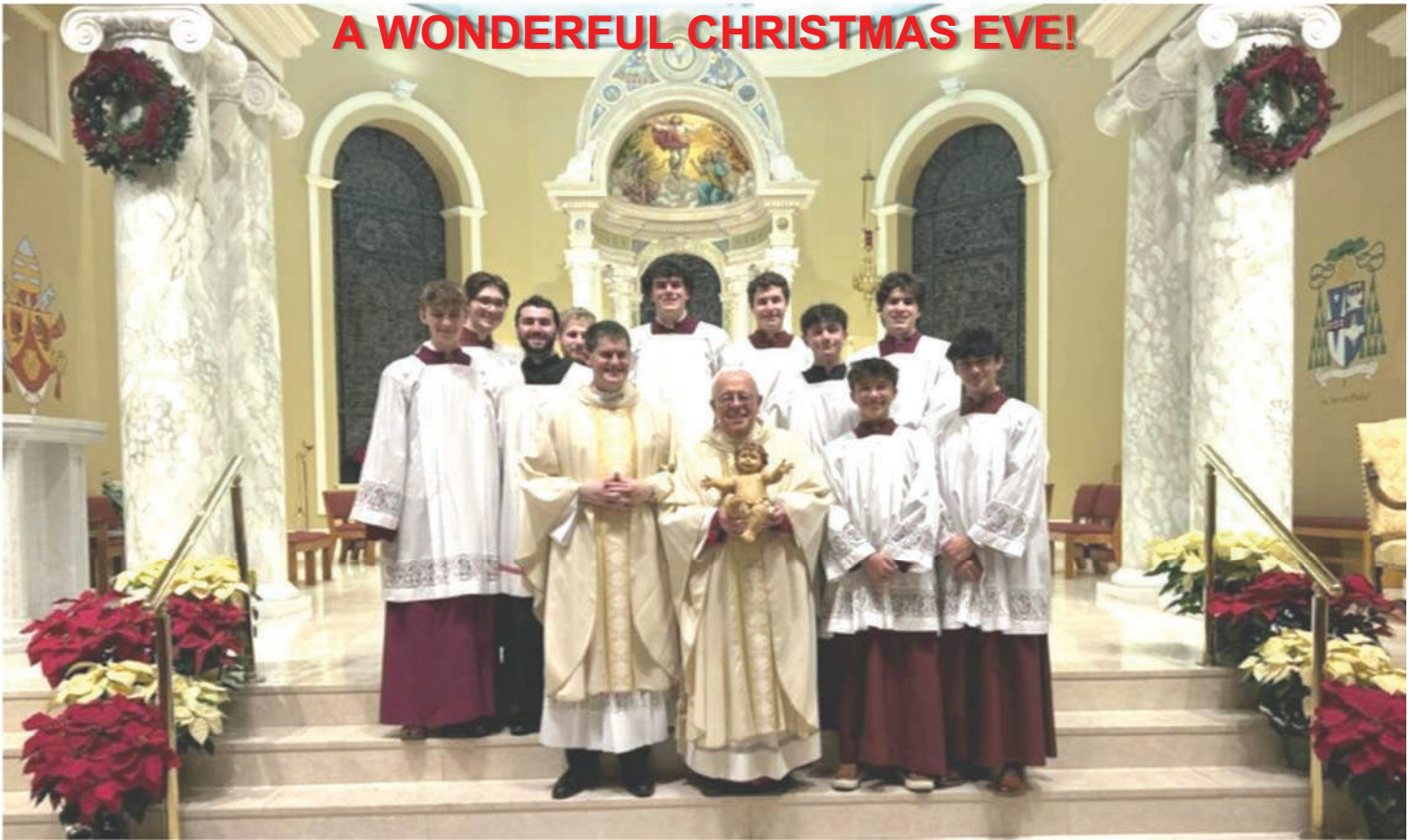

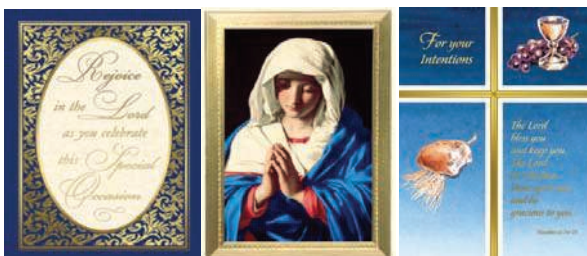
