

Substitute Adorer

A substitute Adorer is a person who fills in for a permanent Adorer (one who has an assigned hour each week) when that person is unable to serve his Holy Hour.

A substitute may be a person who is not able to commit to a weekly Holy Hour for a number of reasons such as a varying work schedule or caring for a family member who has medical needs that may arise unexpectedly.

A substitute may also be a person who is not sure he can make a weekly commitment and wants to first try adoration on a less frequent schedule.

Lastly, a substitute may even be a permanent Adorer who already has an assigned hour and is willing to make the additional sacrifice of being available to cover additional hours on an as needed basis.

How to Sign Up:

Complete an invitation to Perpetual Adoration form located on the table in the rear of the chapel. You may also complete the sign-up section on this website.

Several Options are Available:

You can indicate your willingness to substitute for adorers within one or more of the Four chapel divisions; Morning (6am-noon), Afternoon (noon-6pm), Evening (6pm-midnight), Night(midnight-6am).

You can indicate your willingness to substitute for a particular hour and/or day of the week. For example, you may agree to fill in Thursdays at 2PM or weekend mornings from 10-noon.

How will you be contacted:

Your name and contact information will be added to the substitute list along with the details of your preferred days and hours.

An Adorer or Hourly coordinator will contact you by your preferred method, (telephone or e-mail) with the request.

How to sign-in for Adoration:

A substitute should sign their name in the sign-in book, located on the table in the chapel vestibule. Write "sub" next to your name and sign beside the hour that you are covering.
